Discuss the context, content, and significance of Newton's *Arithmetica universalis*. It is *suggested* that your essay focus on three or four of the following points, but note that this list is offered for guidance only and should not inhibit your own ideas.

- (1) The motivation for Newton's work and the context within which it appeared.
- (2) The terminology and concepts employed in particular, Newton's conception of algebra.
- (3) The technical content of the work.
- (4) The manner in which the work was published and received.
- (5) The influence of the Arithmetica universalis in Britain and abroad.
